

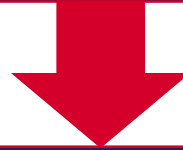

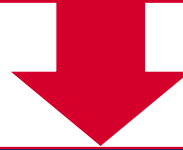


## Registration through 3<sup>rd</sup> party certification process

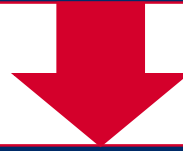
BAFE establish and develop schemes

Companies with third party certification achieved - gain BAFE approval

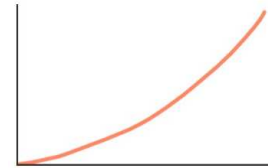

# Kitchen Fire Protection Scheme

- Industry and insurer request
- Poor maintenance, no industry control
- Broaden the BAFE offering
- Insurer awareness due to increased claims
- 18 months developing



## Current Status

- No 3<sup>rd</sup> Party certification of installations
- Current standards cover products and limited type of fire LPS1223, UL300
- Poor cleaning regime
- High value property losses



## SP206 Kitchen Fire Protection Scheme

- Covers Design, installation, commissioning, recharge and maintenance
- Not modular – All areas to be covered
- Allows for subcontracting
- Recognition of other services e.g duct cleaning, integration with main FD&A system; fuel cut-off
- Certificate of compliance for every system



## SP206 Kitchen Fire Protection Scheme

- Low cost membership of scheme
- Tailored specific training for auditors
- Identification of critical components
- Launch Q3 2018



## Benefit to the end user/responsible person



- Assurance of using competent, knowledgeable providers
- Evidence of due diligence taken
- Potential for lighter touch from insurance underwriters
